The **Resilient Cities Congress series** was launched in 2010 by **ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability**, the leading global network of 1,500+ cities, towns and regions committed to building a sustainable future. The aim was to establish the first global forum on local level climate adaptation and resilience. Today, ICLEI Resilient Cities is the leading platform for local governments, the private sector, international organizations, and academia to discuss the latest developments in urban resilience and adaptation. It also serves as an annual meeting point to track local progress on the resilience targets of SDG11. Through our collective efforts, we impact more than 25% of the global population.

Over the last ten years, Resilient Cities has congregated around **4,000 participants** from over **350 cities** worldwide from **84 countries**. Cities from both the **Global South** and the **Global North** have been represented at the Congress. Among them: Accra, Bangkok, Buenos Aires, Cairo, Cape Town, Copenhagen, Ho Chi Minh City, Istanbul, Jakarta, Melbourne, Mexico City, Mumbai, Nairobi, Oslo, Paris, Singapore, Stockholm, Tel Aviv, Tokyo, Vancouver, and more.
