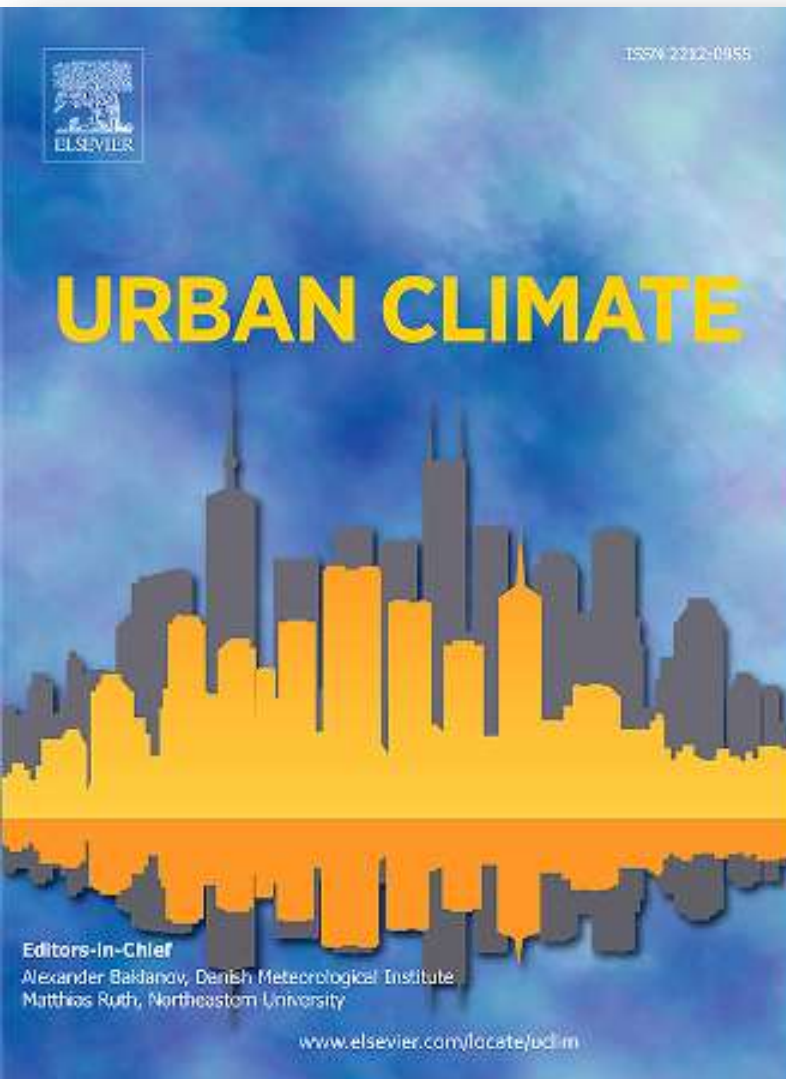


Goal:
