The **Resilient Cities Congress series** was launched in 2010 by **ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability**, the leading global network of 1,500+ cities, towns and regions committed to building a sustainable future. The aim was to establish the first global forum on local level climate adaptation and resilience. Today, ICLEI Resilient Cities is the leading platform for local governments, the private sector, international organizations, and academia to discuss the latest developments in urban resilience and adaptation. It also serves as an annual meeting point to track local progress on the resilience targets of SDG11. Through our collective efforts, we impact more than 25% of the global population.

The **10th anniversary edition** of the ICLEI Resilient Cities Congress will take place from **26-28 June 2019** in Bonn, Germany. Resilient Cities 2019 will celebrate a decade of sharing knowledge and expertise for the advancement of urban resilience and adaptation. At this special edition we are expecting over 500 participants, among them representatives from all relevant UN and international organizations, local and national governments, academia, civil society, and the private sector, including SMEs. The main objective of the 2019 edition is to support cities around the globe to deliver urban resilience. The Congress will showcase innovative technologies that will help cities address major shocks and stresses they are currently facing.
